

Biathlon Ontario 2020 Ontario Winter Games

Eligibility / Selection Criteria

Eligibility Requirements

1. Must be a registered member in good standing with Biathlon Ontario.
2. Athletes must be born in years 2004-2008, inclusive. Athletes born in 2009 can apply for an exemption IAW Appendix 7.
3. Once selected, must have signed the athlete code of conduct.
4. Biathlon Ontario has allocated the 20 male + 20 female billets/competitor spots to each provincially-recognized club based on relative proportions of the overall provincial membership for these age categories. Individual clubs will determine their own internal selection criteria and nomination process to fill each of their assigned billets as follows:

Participant Registration

All Games participants who qualified or will qualify to complete at the Games (including Athletes, Coaches, Managers, Officials, & PSO Reps must complete this on-line registration **before January 27th, 2020**.

Please note that each participant registration must have a unique email address attached to it. If there are multiple participants per household, the person registering them must provide a different email address for each participant.

Participation Fees

All meals, accommodations, on-site transportation, Games-related activities, etc. are provided by the Ontario Winter Games Council. Participating clubs will be assessed a \$60 race fee per athlete they are sending after registration has closed January 27th. It is the discretion of each club whether to absorb this minor cost or collect the race fee from their member athletes.

There are no fees for coaches or officials.

APPEALS PROCESS

Only appeals based on the misapplication of this criteria will be heard. Appeals will be addressed in accordance with the Biathlon Ontario Dispute Resolution Policy.

Appeals must be submitted by email to Cory Lohnes, Biathlon Ontario President at President@BiathlonOntario.ca by 23:59 on January 20th, 2020. The appeal must clearly identify what section of the Selection Criteria was misapplied and how.
