



2019 Blind River Biathlon Invitational

The Blind River Biathlon Invitational will be hosted by the Blind River Cross-Country Ski Club, Saturday March 23, 2019, at the Boom Camp ski trails in Blind River, Ontario.

Saturday's race format will be the **Sprint**, three or four bouts of shooting with penalty loops for targets missed. This event is **air rifle only** (rifles will be made available to those who do not have their own) and will include both prone and standing positions (prone only for Open, Junior and Juvenile categories). Registration is from 10:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m.

There will be an open participation category for anyone who wants to give the sport of biathlon a try. Please consult the Registration Form on this web site.

As always, volunteers are sought to help set up, run and officiate this event. Please contact Michel Menard on the day of the event.

Race fee is **\$15.00** (plus a \$5.00 day fee for non-BiCan members). Day pass for the Blind River Cross-Country Ski Club is **\$10.00** a day for non-members.

Zeroing will begin on Saturday at **11:30 a.m.** Race starts at **12:30 p.m.**

Saturday's categories and racing format:

Sprint Race

Juvenile Boys/Girls (11-12): 3 bouts of shooting (prone, prone, prone), once around the blue loop (1.7km), 3 times around the green loop (1km) = approx. 4.7 km (BGGG)

Junior Boys/Girls (13-14): 3 bouts of shooting (prone, prone, prone), 3 times around the blue loop (1.7km), once around the green loop (1km) = approx. 6.1 km (BBBG)

Senior Boys/Girls (15-16), Open Competitive: 4 bouts of shooting (prone, standing, prone, standing), 4 times around the blue loop (1.7km), once around the green loop (1km) = approx. 8.5 km (BBBBG modified)

Novice Boys/Girls and Novice Open: 3 bouts of shooting (prone, prone, prone), 3 times around the green loop (1km) = approx. 3 km (GGG). Participants in these categories will shoot first, ski the penalty loops, then ski the green loop, thereby eliminating one green loop from the total.

The Categories and Individual start order will be decided after registration. Communication to coaches will be during the Team Captains meeting at 11:45 a.m. Saturday.

Note: The competition committee reserves the right to change start times subject to weather conditions. The committee also reserves the right to cancel or postpone races and to retain up to 25% of the entry fees to cover expenses.
