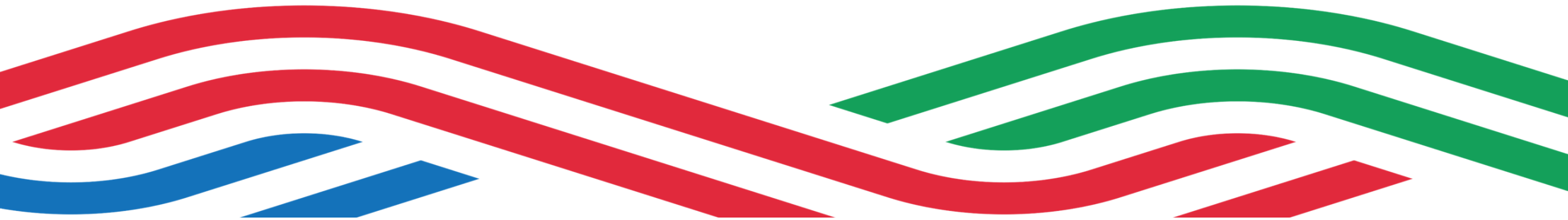

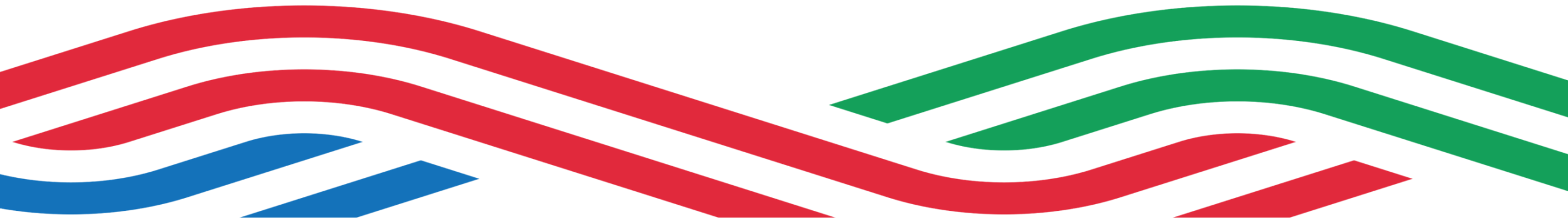

ACCREDITATION

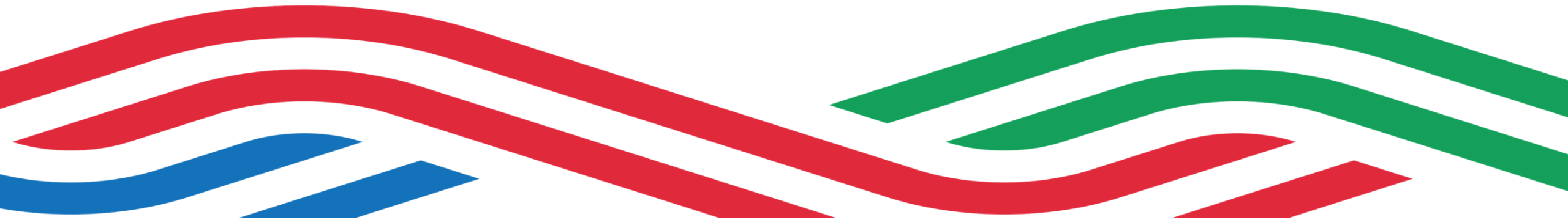

ACCOMMODATIONS

- Check-in Process – PSO Reps will be the representatives for the sport and will be designated as the check-in lead. PSO Reps will check-in on behalf of their sport and receive pre-programmed room keys at the front desk. PSO Reps will be responsible for distributing room keys to their participants. Room keys are based upon final rooming list.
- Check-out Process – Keys must be returned to the front desk prior to final departure from the hotel.

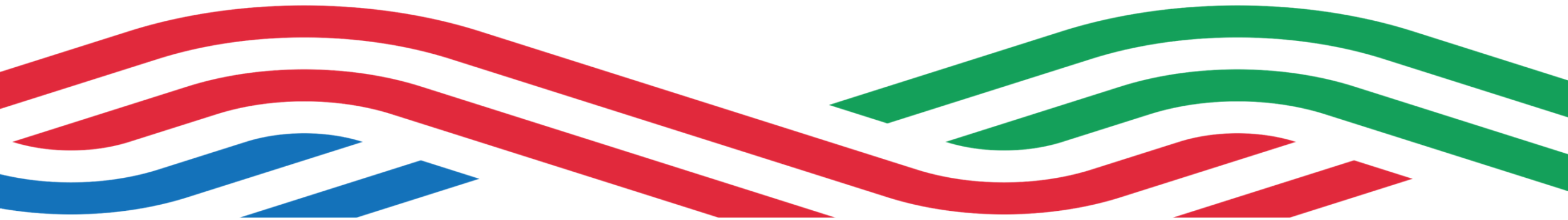

TRANSPORTATION

- Bus transportation is provided to and from competition venues, Opening Ceremony and meal locations. No transportation is provided after a participant's final event as it is the expectation that participant's will depart from their competition venue (unless previously specified for those external travel pre-approvals).

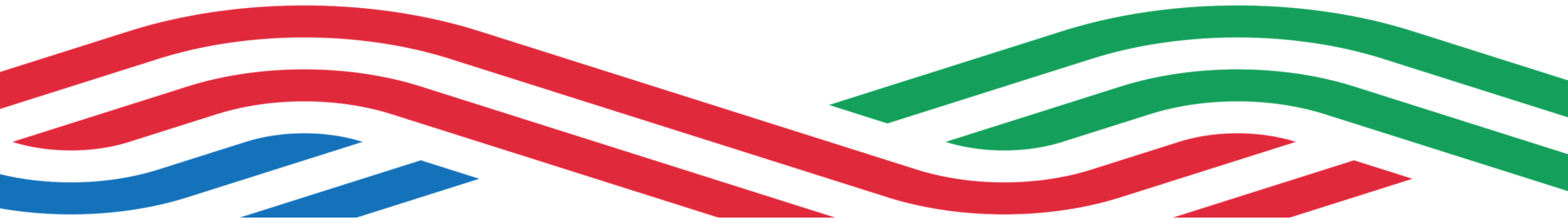

TRANSPORTATION

- The buses will run as close to these times as possible.
- For those sports at multiple hotels, the bus might be picking up at both locations on the same trip therefore will be at one hotel at the posted time and will service the other hotel shortly after.
- Please have coaches/managers ensure athletes are ready at the pickup locations for the posted time. Buses will not be held for late arriving athletes. Due to the large number of participants at the Games most of the buses are scheduled to do additional pick-ups for other sports so delays from one sport could cause issues for another. As mentioned buffer times are built in but some transports are tighter than others.
- We also want to provide a reminder that officials are **not** provided with transportation for competition, as we confirmed this in our planning meetings.



FOOD SERVICES

General Information

- A hot breakfast will be provided at the hotel prior to transportation to your competition.
- A boxed lunch will be provided at the sport venue.
- A hot dinner will be provided at the hotel, sport venue or a different venue/ restaurant depending on the duration of your sport and the total number of participants.
- Snacks will **not** be provided; please bring snacks to supplement between meals.
- Dietary restrictions were collected during Registration. If you **did not** indicate any dietary restrictions during Registration and require this, please contact your PSO Rep.
- Our facilities are not nut free, nor can we confirm that products brought into our facilities are prepared in nut free environments.

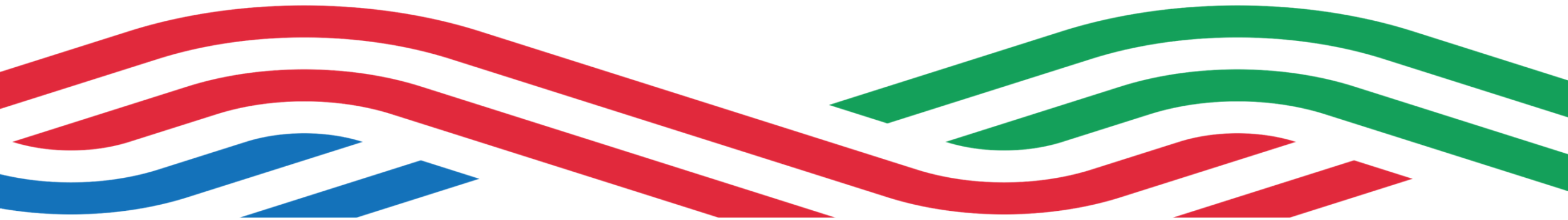

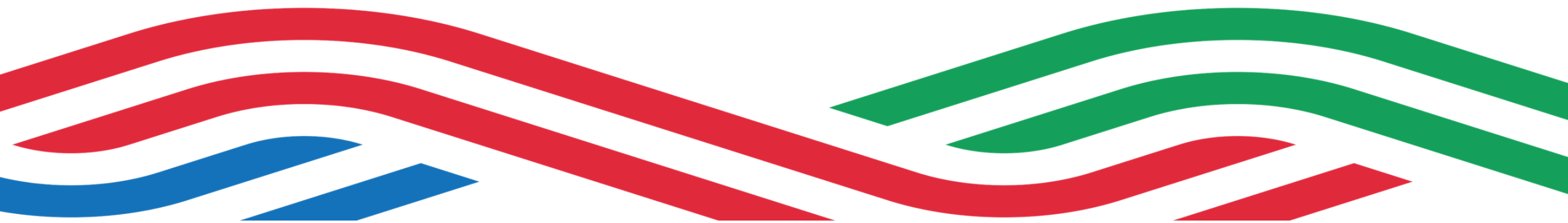

Rowan's Law

- 2026 Ontario Winter Games hosted by the City of Orillia Mandate:

The City of Orillia is committed to ensuring the safety of all individuals who participate in the 2026 Ontario Winter Games. Ontario Regulation 161/19 of Rowan's Law (Concussion Safety), requires all sport organizations as defined in the Regulation, which includes the City of Orillia to have a Concussion Code of Conduct.

The Act requires athletes, parents or guardians, coaches, team trainers, and officials to confirm that they have reviewed the Concussion Code of Conduct. You were required to review and confirm receipt that you reviewed the Code of Conduct as well as the Removal from Play and Return to Sport protocols prior to completing your registration.

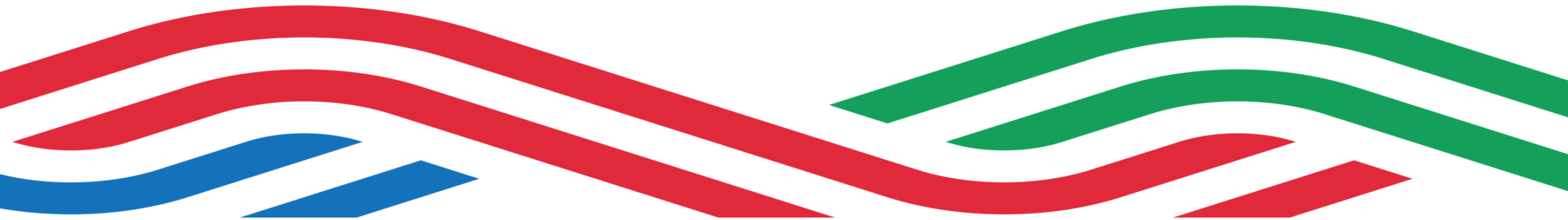

Concussion Signs and Symptoms

- Loss of consciousness
- Seizure or convulsion
- Balance problems
- Nausea/vomiting
- Drowsiness
- More emotional
- Irritability
- Sadness
- Fatigue/low energy
- Nervous/anxious
- “Don’t feel right”
- Difficulty remembering
- Headache
- Dizziness
- Confusion
- Feeling slowed down
- Pressure in head
- Blurred vision
- Sensitivity to light/noise
- Amnesia
- Feeling in a fog
- Neck pain
- Difficulty concentrating

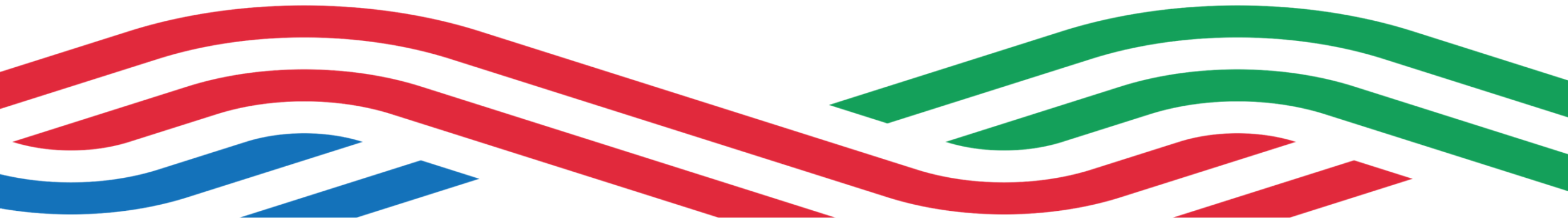

Withdrawal From Play

- The CMO is responsible for decisions that impact the safety of the athlete at the games
- The decision of the CMO is final – decisions from the CMO can be made at the venue
- The CMO is the only medical staff to change “withdrawal from Competition” to “Return to Competition”
- PSOs are responsible for monitoring the athlete based on medical decisions



Medical

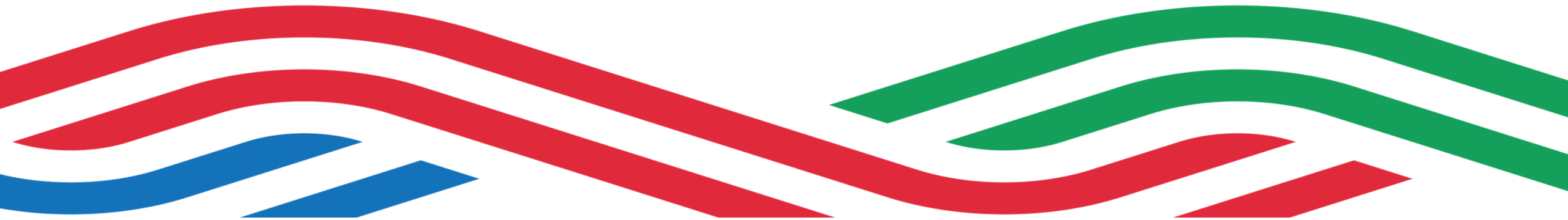
- The Medical Team is committed to providing the best care experience for an athlete and participant should they become ill or injured.

Medical

Confidentiality

- Games environment does not change the requirement for confidentiality
- Discussions regarding injury and /or injury management may take place only among relevant medical personnel involved in the participant's care
- All requests for medical information outside of the immediate medical providers will be directed to the CMO
- Medical information will be released to media only by the CMO or his designate and only with written consent from the participant (and their guardian if underage)

Medical services provided to participants on site

- Triage will call 911 if needed
- Medical assessment and treatment
- Referral and follow up to specialty clinics
- Wound care

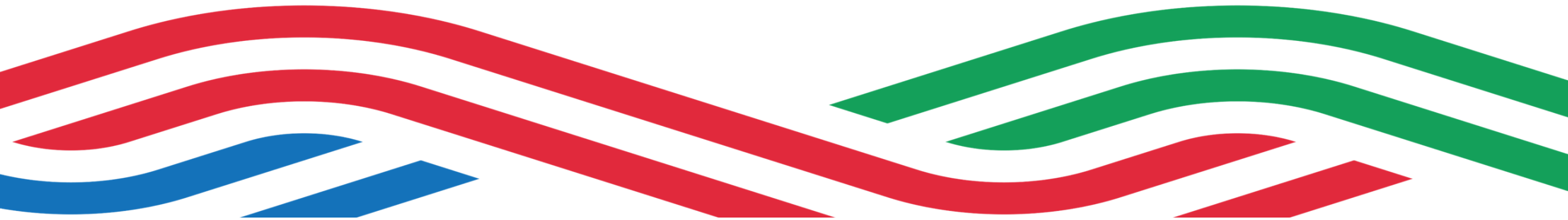

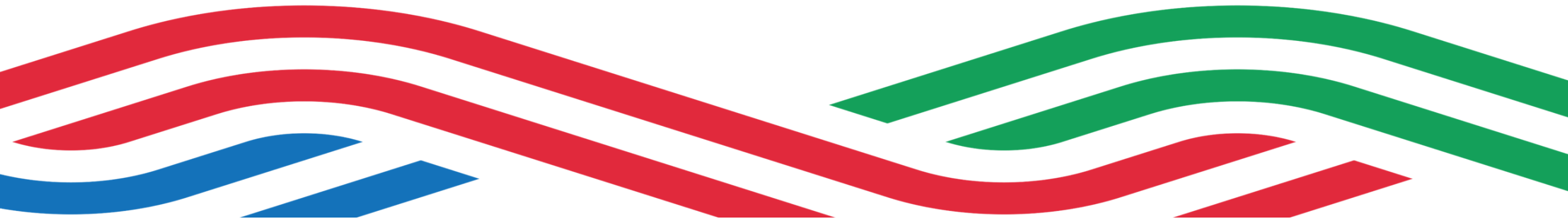
